## RAVALLI COUNTY BURN PERMIT 1/26/16

On February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016 Ravalli County residents will be able to obtain a burn permit that may be activated on **March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016**. Residents may obtain a permit by:

Using the internet by going to [BurnPermits.mt.gov](http://BurnPermits.mt.gov) (takes approximately four minutes to obtain).

Responding to the Ravalli County Sheriff's Office Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, or Friday between 1p.m. and 4p.m.

Any questions can be answered by reviewing the Burn Permit information at Ravalli County Sheriff's Office web page, Ravalli County Sheriff's Office Facebook page, by contacting the Ravalli County Dispatch Center at 363-3033, by contacting Lt. Zae Hudson (375-4020), or contacting your local Fire Chief.

You may obtain a burn permit on-line by going to [BurnPermit.mt.gov](http://BurnPermit.mt.gov). Once you are on the site:

Select "Start".

Select "Ravalli" and "Continue".

From the menu Select "Obtain a permit".

Enter Name, Address, City, Zip Code, and Phone Number. Select "Continue".

Confirm the address as the location of the burn or enter additional burn locations (User must Select Add Burn Location).

Select "I'm done adding burn locations".

Edit information or Select "Information is Correct".

Agree with Terms and Conditions by Selecting "I agree".

Select "Continue".

E-mail or print the permit.

If you have a 2015 Ravalli County Burn Permit, you can renew your permit for the 2016 season. This can be accomplished at the [BurnPermit.mt.gov](http://BurnPermit.mt.gov) web page. To renew a permit go to the web page, select Start, choose Ravalli County, select Continue, and select Renew an existing permit.

The burn permit is free for the 2016 burn season and the permit is valid for the entire burn season (March 1<sup>st</sup>-November 30<sup>th</sup>).

You must activate the burn permit for each day that you will burn. You may activate a burn permit by responding to the [BurnPermit.mt.gov](http://BurnPermit.mt.gov) site or by calling 1-866-212-6318. If you experience technical difficulties, you may contact the Ravalli County Dispatch Center at 363-3033 or Lt. Zae Hudson at 375-4020.

If you do not have internet access, you may respond to the Ravalli County Sheriff's Office on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, or Friday from 1p.m. – 4p.m. to obtain a burn permit.

**Once you have a burn permit, you will have to activate the permit each day that you want to burn.** Activation can be completed on-line (BurnPermit.mt.gov) or by telephone (1-866-212-6318). The on-line activation does not cost Ravalli County anything. The telephone activation cost Ravalli County .15 cents per minute for the call. If you have access to the internet, please activate your burn permit on line to keep the costs down.

Internet Tips:

When you want to access the BurnPermit.mt.gov internet site, enter BurnPermit.mt.gov in your domain field; this field is at the top left of your computer screen and usually starts with http://. Delete all the characters in this field and type BurnPermit.mt.gov and press enter. This will take you directly to the burn permit site.
