




## Am I at risk of breast cancer?

According to the American Cancer Society, “simply being a woman is the main risk factor for developing breast cancer. Men can develop breast cancer, but this disease is about 100 times more common among women than men.

**Aging:** Your risk of developing breast cancer increases as you get older. About 1 out of 8 invasive breast cancers are found in women younger than 45, while about 2 of 3 invasive breast cancers are found in women age 55 or older.

**Genetics:** About 5% to 10% of breast cancer cases are thought to be hereditary, meaning that they result directly from gene defects (called *mutations*) inherited from a parent.”
