The BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS met with W. L. Higginbotham, Road Supervisor, for the weekly road update meeting. Today the Road Department will be cutting brush on West Fork Road. The Conner Cutoff Road has been finished. Most of the material was chipped and hauled to a local mill to be dumped in their chip pile.

The road department will also be working on the culvert on North Birch Creek Road and on Thursday, hopes to begin hauling to Pleasant View Road if the weather holds out.

The road department has been using an old tar pot to boil water to thaw frozen, jammed culverts. It has been working very well although it does take about two (2) hours to boil the water (250-300 gallons). Right now it takes approximately one (1) hour to break through a culvert and Larry feels it will work much more efficiently with a high pressure washer.

Chairman Allen asked if that would work on the Holly Lane culvert and Larry said the area that is having the ice flow problem does not have a culvert. The water is coming from a field, crossing the road, and continuing through someone's yard. A discussion followed about the cause of the ice flow and possible solutions. Larry will check on the situation further.

The BOARD and Larry also discussed the corner on Old Darby Road. The road department has cleaned out the brush and hopes to be able to widen the corner.

Larry got a 45' easement on the first 90 degree turn on Pleasant View Road. This will enable the road department to straighten that corner somewhat.

Larry gave the BOARD a report on the crusher. The report details a number of items but determines that the crusher is definitely economical to run.

The BOARD and Tracy D. Turbak, County Finance Officer, held the

mid-year budget review for the road department.

The BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS and Tracy Turbak, County Finance Officer, met with Debbie Harmon, Clerk of Court, and Dave Demmons, Youth Court Probation Officer, for their respective mid-year budget reviews.

Commissioner Powell met with Warren and Connie Mytty regarding a community decay problem.
