On Saturday October 31st, the Ravalli County Sheriff's Office arrested three adults for Criminal Possession of Dangerous Drugs and Criminal Possession of Dangerous Drugs with the Intent to Distribute after the RCSO received information that large amounts of heroin was being brought into Ravalli County. With assistance from Stevensville Police Department and Missoula County Sheriff's Office the RCSO intercepted a motor vehicle entering Ravalli County with approximately \$225,000 worth of heroin, methamphetamine, and prescription opiates. The RCSO confirmed that the drugs were intended for distribution in Western Montana. The quantity of heroin, in excess of a half-pound, is the largest ever recovered in Ravalli County.

Those arrested were 47 year old Marlen Revelo and 23 year old Mason Gregory Skerbeck, both from Port Angeles, WA and 21 year old Crystal Lee Griffin of Stevensville, MT. All three were in a rental car with Washington registration which was stopped by deputies on US Highway 93 near Florence.

Deputies obtained a search warrant for the car and recovered 257.4 grams of Heroin and more than 230 grams of Methamphetamine, as well as other assorted narcotics, paraphernalia, \$1,730 in cash and a loaded .380 caliber pistol.

Revelo, Skerbeck and Griffin have all been charged with multiple counts of Conspiracy: Criminal Distribution of Dangerous Drugs, and Criminal Possession of Dangerous Drugs with the Intent to Distribute.

All three remain in custody in the Ravalli County Detention Center at this time.
