On August 23, 2013 James Robert Colvin JR registered with the Ravalli County Sheriff's Office as required by Montana State Law. Miller, the individual who appears on this notification, has been convicted of sex offenses that require registration. The WA Department of Corrections conducted an assessment and designated Colvin as a Level 3.

COLVIN IS NOT WANTED BY THE POLICE AT THIS TIME.

THIS NOTIFICATION IS NOT INTENDED TO INCREASE FEAR; RATHER, IT IS OUR BELIEF THAT AN INFORMED PUBLIC IS A SAFER PUBLIC.

The Ravalli County Sheriff's Office does not have the legal authority to direct where a sex offender may or may not live unless court ordered restrictions exist.

Sexual offenders have always lived in our communities. Due to changes in the Montana Code Annotated in 1997, law enforcement is now able to share information about sex offenders with you. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate, or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated. Further, such abuse could potentially end law enforcement's ability to do community notifications. We believe the only person who wins if community notification ends is the sex offender, since sex offenders derive their power through secrecy.
