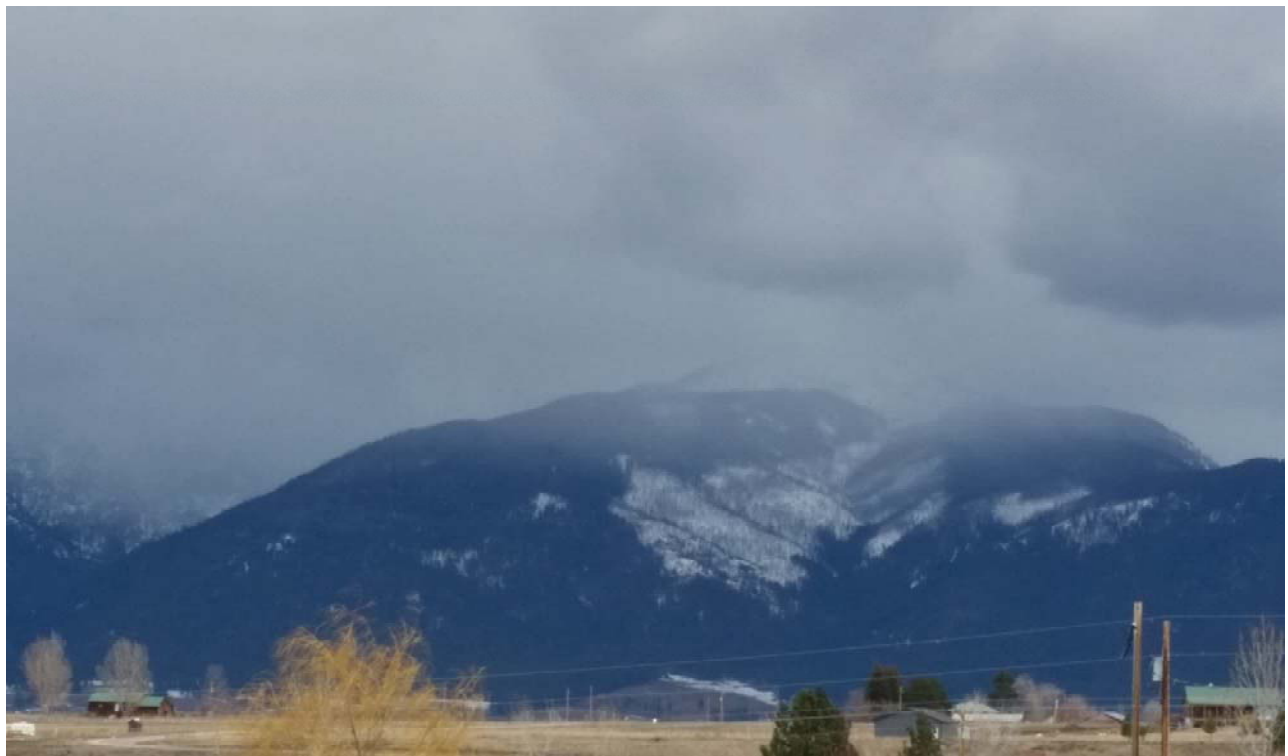

**Hamilton is the county seat and is located in the central part of the county. The county includes the incorporated cities of Stevensville, Pinesdale, Hamilton and Darby. Florence, Victor, Corvallis, Grantsdale, Conner and Sula are also located in our county.**

**Ravalli County has both the Lolo and the Bitterroot National Forests dominating the majority of our county. The Lolo has 8,884 acres in the county, and the Bitterroot has 1.1 million acres in our county. This provides a great opportunity for outdoor recreation.**




# RAVALLI COUNTY 911 CENTER

The Ravalli county 911 center responds to approximately 13,000 911 calls, 120,000 phone calls and approximately 32,000 calls for service yearly. We dispatch for 12 fire departments, three ambulance services and five local law enforcement agencies.

Our center is staffed with thirteen Communications Specialist and we have at least two team members ready to serve our community 24 hours a day.

Our recently remodeled center will have new furniture this year, which will provide a six position console. All of our equipment is modern as our vision is to continually seek new technology to assist public safety and responder safety. Our center includes a conference/training room, individual lockers and a full kitchen.
