

Pre Fire Season Health Screening

Wildfire smoke is an almost seasonal experience to communities in Western Montana. Following the unprecedented levels of smoke in Seeley Lake last summer, our group at The University of Montana is partnering with the Ravalli County Health Department to assess the health impact of these exposures. Please join us to receive free health screenings and to better inform Montana communities for future smoke events. Participants will also be asked to participate in follow-up screenings.

The screening will take about 30 minutes and all results are confidential.
