The Town continues to follow the direction of the Ravalli County Health Department, and the State of Montana in relation to the COVID-19 health outbreak.

With the release of [Governor Bullock's phased reopening plan](#), the Town has implemented protocols to ensure the safety of citizens and staff while the community reopens and recovers from the effects of COVID-19. Modification to facilities have been completed and plans for sanitation of public areas are being finalized to satisfy the guidelines of Governor Bullock's reopening directives.

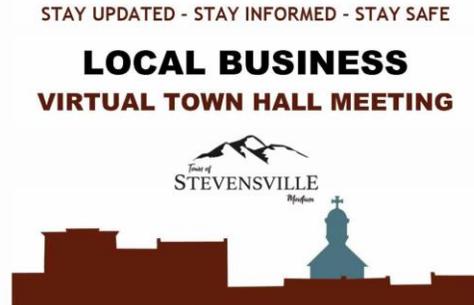
