SPECIAL RULES FOR GRAINS & GRASSES:

- The Exhibitor must have grown exhibit.
- The Exhibitor should state name of variety on entry blank.
- All sheaves of grain, forage crops and grasses must not be less than three nor more than five inches in diameter just below the bundle head. Grains must be tied in at least three places: forages and grasses in at least one place.

THRESHED GRAIN

- A sample shall be **ONE PINT** of the grain of either 2018-2019 threshed grains.

PREPARATION OF FORAGE CROPS

Samples should be representative of the variety. Sample should be: clean, of good color, uniform of size, free from yellow berries, cracked seed, and particularly

from weed seeds of any kind as well as variety mixtures. It should not show evidence of frost, weather, insect damage of any kind, or disease.

- Grain should be heavy and of good test weight.
- The Exhibitor must properly identify samples.
