Class G - Pastry - All entries must use homemade pastry dough. Items on a plate in zip bag.

By definition, "pastry" is a major type of bakers' confectionery. It includes various kinds of baked products made from a stiff dough which is made from flour, salt, a relatively high proportion of fat, and a small proportion of liquid. It also may include sugar or flavorings. Most pastry is leavened only by the action of steam as it bakes, but some items defined as "pastries" may contain yeast or other leavening agent. Pastry dough is used as a base and/or covering for sweet or savory items. **Please note that although "pies" are considered a pastry, they have a separate class.*
