RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Refer to General Livestock Rules.
2. Pen assignments will be made off of the entry form.
3. Exhibitors will be awarded only two premiums per lot.
4. Exhibitors with registered sheep must have registration papers with them at Fair on each animal. Registration papers must be presented to Superintendents upon request. Failure to show papers to the Superintendents upon request will disqualify entries in these lots.
5. Breeding sheep must be owned 60 days prior to the start of the Fair.
6. All animals to be shown in lots of pairs must have been shown individually.
7. Every ewe two years of age or over must have produced a lamb within nine months preceding the Fair.
8. **Scrapie tag will be in the sheep's ear before it enters the Fairgrounds.**

9. Scrapie: Exhibitors must follow all current state and federal regulations concerning "Scrapie" disease. If you have any questions call the MT USDA APHIS Veterinary Services at 406-449-2220.
