### RECIPIENTS

- · Frontline healthcare workers
- Long-term Care and Assisted Living Facilities (LTC/ALF)
- Healthcare workers with direct patient contact or virus exposure





Anticipated mid/late January 2021

- · Persons aged 70 years and older
- American Indians and other people of color who may be at elevated risk for COVID-19 complications
- Persons aged 16-69 with high-risk medical conditions





Anticipated mid/late April 2021

- Frontline Essential Workers
- · Persons aged 60 years and older
- Individuals residing in congregate care and correctional facilities
- Persons aged 16-59 with medical conditions not included in Phase 1B that may have an elevated risk of COVID-19 complications





Anticipated July 2021

 All remaining Montanans aged 16 years and older


### COVID-19 VACCINE ADMINISTRATION BY COUNTY OF RESIDENCE
