**RAVALLI COUNTY COVID-19 Vaccine Update  
PUBLIC HEALTH**

Hamilton, Mont. – Ravalli County Public Health has launched an online form for Ravalli County residents to register their Notice of Intent to receive the COVID-19 vaccine from Public Health. This registry is not a ‘waiting list’, however; it will serve as a database that Public Health can reference to make appointments as more vaccine becomes available. Registration is open to all Ravalli County residents, not just those included in the current vaccination phases.

Community members are asked to assist our elderly population who may not have the capability or access in submitting their information. Additionally, Public Health will be coordinating this information with other community organizations and agencies to ensure that those residents who are elderly, homebound, or may not have access to this information are not overlooked and are able to receive the vaccine, if desired.

This registry is only for those who wish to receive the COVID-19 vaccine from Public Health. Other providers in Ravalli County each have their own method of registering for an appointment. Submission does not guarantee an appointment within a particular timeframe. Additionally, Ravalli County Public Health will not guarantee appointments in any particular order with respect to the time of submission.
