**RAVALLI COUNTY COVID-19 Update
PUBLIC HEALTH**

Hamilton, Mont. – Ravalli County Public Health is reporting 11 cases for 2/9 and 2/10 with 85 open cases as of 4pm.

We encourage residents to continue to follow the guidance, Wash your hands, Wear your mask and Watch your distance. Keep your cohort groups small and stay home if you are sick.

Ravalli County Public Health is pleased to share in the mass clinic hosted by Marcus Daly this Saturday, February 13, 2021. The hospital was one of many hospitals across the state that received 975 doses of Pfizer, reallocated from CVS/Walgreens. Public Health has been working closely with community partners approved by the state to receive allocations of COVID vaccine in an effort to share limited supplies. Each of the partners have worked tirelessly to contact and schedule 200 residents previously signed up on waiting lists. Public Health did a random draw of 200 residents with submitted “Notice of Intent” and began making calls on Wednesday. As of 4pm today we have filled all 200 of our spots.
