## RAVALLI COUNTY COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH UPDATE

Hamilton, Mont...Ravalli County Public Health will be offering the pediatric Pfizer beginning next Wednesday the 24<sup>th</sup>. Please call to schedule an appointment. Appointments for adult Covid vaccine is available on Mondays and Tuesdays, with walk-ins welcome between 9 am and 4pm on Tuesdays, closed over the noon hour.

Public Health is seeing a steady decline in daily reported positive cases to the local health department. Total active cases in isolation as of 4pm today is 77. The total number may not accurately reflect all positive cases, as we are aware that not all residents are reporting positive results to Public Health with use of home testing kits. A reminder to residents with regards to home testing, reporting is recommended and necessary if an isolation letter or release of isolation letter is needed for work/ school/travel or other purposes.
