## **RAVALLI COUNTY COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH UPDATE**

Hamilton, Mont. – Ravalli County Public Health has completed the automated survey for contact tracing COVID-19. The survey was completed last week with the help of several other counties that are moving to this strategy. Test surveys were sent out via text message to county residents this last week. The text message contains our Public Health logo and a short greeting along with a link to the survey. Residents that have recently tested positive for COVID are asked to click on the link and complete the short survey. The purpose of the short survey is to continue to track and capture data about the COVID-19 virus. The survey takes approximately 3-4 minutes to complete and will generate isolation dates and information regarding isolation and close contacts.
