RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Large items may be delivered to grounds Sunday through Wednesday (right after the parade) of Fair week. There will be no one to receive and look after these items until Tuesday. **All items must be on the grounds by 1pm Wednesday, as judging begins at 3pm.**
2. All ribbons are to be displayed on items until Saturday evening, including parade ribbons.
3. All items must have a sign that identifies its make, model, year (if possible), and description.
4. A Blue Ribbon winning entry cannot be re-entered for judging for three years, but is welcome for general display.
5. All items must be over 40 years old, except scratch-built replicas of antique engines, tractors implements, auto or etc. NO KITS
6. Exhibitors may enter up to three (3) exhibits per lot.

7. Judging will be done on restoration or if unrestored, condition, rarity of item, authenticity or completeness. After market add-ons allowed in unrestored.
8. Exhibitors entering in Lots A-F only will be given a pass for entry onto the Fairgrounds.

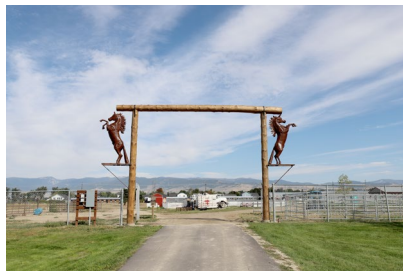

1. Refer to General Rules & Regulations.
2. **A maximum of eight (8) exhibits per Exhibitor and only one (1) exhibit in any class.**
3. **ALL ENTRIES ARE SIZE LIMITED DUE TO SPACE. PLEASE NOTHING BIGGER THAN 16 X 20.**
4. All exhibits in this department must be the original work of the Exhibitor (not a photo-copy) and must have been done within the last three years.
5. This Department will not accept paintings copied from art books, non-original photos, paint by number, nor any commercial kit crafts.
6. Computer/Digital Art: Two Dimensional art created partially or totally through the use of a computer. All components (photos, graphics, etc.) must be the original work of the submitting artist.
7. Judging will be based on the effective use of principles of art and skill. Originality is very important and will be given preference. Where there is no competition, a premium will be awarded only if the article merits award.
8. **Paintings, drawings, etc. MUST BE FRAMED OR MATTED. FRAMED ART MUST BE EQUIPPED WITH WIRE PICTURE HANGERS FOR DISPLAY. Canvas wrap also accepted. MATTED ART MUST HAVE A STURDY WALL HANGER.**
9. Paint on all paintings and varnish on all wood must be dry.
10. Professional artists may be invited to display one piece of their art, please check with the Superintendent for available space.
11. The Superintendent may reject any entry not having sufficient merit, reclassify where necessary, or refuse to display entries which are not appropriate for family viewing.
12. Exhibitors must be age 18 years old or older as of August 1st.

THE BITTER ROOT ARTS GUILD will grant BRAG special ribbons and a cash prize of

\$25.00 to the entrants of their choice. There will be 10 ribbons and cash awards in both Adult and Junior divisions.

Guidelines for Judging:

1. Composition: placement of focal point, line of sight or action suggested by arrangement of elements drawing your eye through the painting, location of horizon.
2. Drawing: is the drawing in proportion and believable, how shapes are used in foreground-distance.
3. Light: warm, cool, bright, natural, direction of the light, are the shadows consistent with the direction of the light, type of light.
4. Color: are the colors harmonious, do the value shifts create distance, use of contrasting colors.
5. Presentation: materials used, framing, hanging choice. Does the mat or frame compliment or distract from the piece. Is it in good repair, no chips or dings?

Tips:

- Hang your pictures at home to make sure your hanger works. Secure adhesive hangers.
- Be sure you are in the correct Division & Class.

Guidelines for Baked Bread

Bread should be so completely baked that when pressed upon it will spring out immediately upon release of pressure. An excellent loaf of bread should be uniform golden brown in color. The flavor should be nutty, agreeable to taste, and with no suggestion of sourness, except for sourdough category. The crumb should be slightly moist, tender, yet not crumbling when compressed; light in weight in proportion to size, even grain, slightly creamy white in color. The crust of the loaf should be tender and of medium thickness.

GUIDELINES FOR CAKES

No Boxed Mixes. Cakes may be 6", 8" or 9" and must be displayed on cardboard, no more than 2" larger than cake, and no pans.

ENTRIES ARE NOT RETURNABLE. A well-made cake properly baked should be uniformly thick, not high in the middle or at the side of the tin, or low in the center. It should be even grained, fine and delicate in texture, according to cake type. Butter cakes should be golden brown in color. To be graded as excellent, butter cakes must be light in weight in proportion to ingredients used. When icing is used, it should be smooth and glossy in appearance, spongy and not brittle when cut, not so soft as to be sticky.
